An extensive re-evaluation of assumptions regarding student capability and what it means to be a literate in the twenty-first-century 'information society' is of critical importance. Such a re-examination allows for extensive reflection on current practices and a powerful critique of 'traditional' academic and research literacy methods, and suggests ways in which practices of quality teaching and learning may be implemented.
